

MoDOT Minute – July 5, 2011

Hi. This is Sally Oxenhandler with your MoDOT Minute.

Because of flooding along the Missouri River, MoDOT is urging travelers headed east or west across the heartland to cross the river in Kansas City. There are only two Missouri River bridges that are not closed because of flooding north of Kansas City. Route 36 at St. Joseph and Route 92 that crosses into Leavenworth, Kansas, are both open but construction could cause delays. MoDOT's flooding web page, [www.modot.org/flooding](http://www.modot.org/flooding), provides information on the latest road closures with a link to the Traveler Information Map and detour information.

Fourteen Missouri law enforcement agencies provided additional enforcement on Interstate 70 on June 24 and 25 as part of the HEAT Is On campaign. They made 1,650 traffic stops, resulting in violations that ranged from DWIs to speeding. The extra enforcement will be in place through Sept. 21.
