

MoDOT Minute – May 31, 2011

As part of its five-year plan to be more efficient and cut costs, MoDOT completed restriping 5,000 miles of the state's most heavily traveled roads last week in time for the busy summer travel season. MoDOT started striping in March instead of April and used just 17 strippers instead of the former 20. Crews worked together and flexed their schedules so that the striping machines were running with two 40-hour shifts a week, often working six to seven days a week all over the state. MoDOT completed the striping without overtime costs.
