

Summary of Route 47 Bridge at Washington
Public Hearing
February 28, 2011

The meeting was held from 5 p.m. until 6:30 p.m. at City Hall in Washington. There were 35 people attending including several engineering consultants, several members of the local Highway 47 Bridge Committee and two media representatives from the Missourian newspaper. Two people submitted comments at the meeting. We also had 338 virtual attendees and 3 comments submitted online.

The primary focus of the meeting was to give the public one last opportunity to comment on the environmental assessment document, which identified the location of a new bridge. The majority of interest from those attending and commenting lie in the connection of the Katy Trail and the importance of offering a pedestrian bridge as part of the new plan.

A handout was presented to all those who attended, and displays were available for viewing and discussion with a MoDOT representative. The EA document was also available.
